## About the Guest Lecturer

Emanuele Viscuso, (born <u>December</u> 24, <u>1952</u> in <u>Palermo</u>, Sicily) is a world-renowned <u>sculptor</u>, musician, designer and a cultural promoter. His most famous piece is the 45-foot-large sculpture "Wave-Bridge on the Imaginary" located at the Milano <u>Malpensa International Airport</u>. In 2006, Mr. Viscuso created the Sicilian Film Festival, a showcase of Sicilian directors and films held in Miami Beach. In 2008, Mr. Viscuso created the F.I.M.O. International Organ Music Festival in the Churches of the Historical Princedom of Castelbuono in <u>Castelbuono</u>, Sicily. As Chairman of the <u>Accademia Italiana della Cucina</u>, a Cultural Institution of the Italian Republic, Mr. Viscuso played an integral role in the Esperia\* STS-120/10A Mission, launched on <u>October</u> 23,

2007 from NASA's <u>Kennedy Space Centre</u>. The City of <u>Miami Beach</u> recognized Mr. Viscuso's cultural involvement in the community with the "*Key to the City of Miami Beach*" on <u>October</u> 17, 2007.
